

Guyana Project June and July 2010

The Missionary Society has an opportunity to help the Guyana SDB Conference with a building project this summer. The project will consist of remodeling the Manse (parsonage) that our missionaries used while serving there. The Manse will become a dormitory for high school students that come in from areas that do not have high schools. On the lower level, there will be a living space for the housemother.

1. We are looking for individuals that have some building skills or can follow directions and are willing to learn. Those interested should be willing to serve for at least three weeks. The project will take at least six weeks.
2. Individuals will need to raise funds for airfare and some money to help with food costs. We estimate two to two thousand five hundred dollars will be required.
3. Living conditions will be similar to camping, and will be in Georgetown proper.

Calvin Babcock, has been designated as the lead person in charge of the group while working there.
